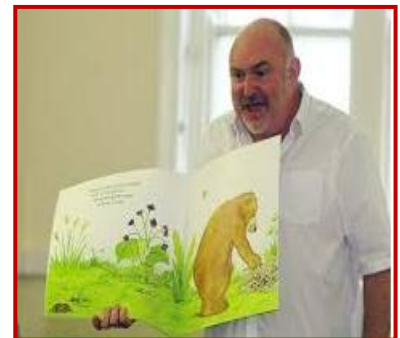
### Parent Governors

**Our Year 5/6 Netball team played against Thythorn Primary school this week and won 23-0. An amazing result and great team effort.**



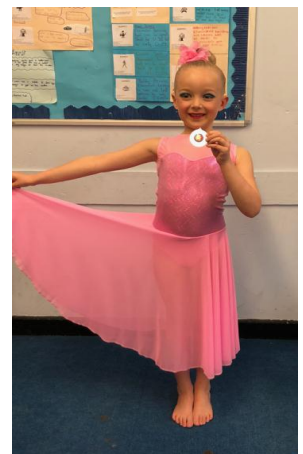
## School Games/Swimming
