### MESSAGE FROM MRS HOLYLAND

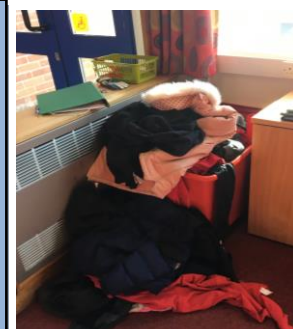
