The broader curriculum books were excellent and showed such a variety of work being covered by the children in so many subjects.

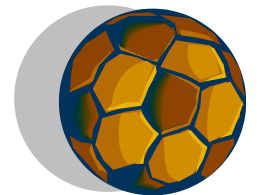
Reception Area Display Board
