## Key Vocabulary

<b>Environment</b>	The local surrounding or a place a person lives or works in
<b>Identity</b>	Who someone is and how they define themselves
<b>Responsibility</b>	Being in charge of our own actions
<b>Rule</b>	Something that tells us what is allowed or not allowed
<b>Volunteer</b>	A person who offers to help with tasks without getting paid
<b>Community</b>	A group of people who have this in common; live in same area, go to the same school, similar backgrounds

## Key Knowledge

- Rules do not just exist in school but also exist in lots of other places
- We can all make a difference even if we cannot change something ourselves. We can bring these issues to the attention of other people who are in a better position to make changes.
- Although lots of people help to make their local area a good place to live, we also have a part to play in this.
