## **Key Vocabulary**

Environment	The local surrounding or a place a person lives or works in
Identity	Who someone is and how they define themselves
Responsibility	Being in charge of our own actions
Rule	Something that tells us what is allowed or not allowed
Volunteer	A person who offers to help with tasks without getting paid
Community	A group of people who have this in common; live in same area, go to the same school, similar backgrounds
