- Golden Rule: 'Treat other people as you would like them to treat you.'
- Some texts from different religions promote the 'Golden Rule', and think about what would happen if people followed this idea more



5. What stories do Christians and Jewish people tell about the beginning of the world and how to treat the world?

- some people believe God created the world and so we should look after it
