Creating Media - Making Music



1. How music makes us feel

- Music creates an emotional response
- *Mars* is louder and has a marching rhythm (like war), whereas *Venus* is slower and quieter (like peace).



2. Rhythms and patterns

- Chrome Music Lab: Rhythm allows you to create rhythms using digital instruments.



3. How music can be used

- Chrome music lab allows you to make music from graphic drawings



4. Notes and tempo

- You can create a pattern of three notes in Song Maker using coloured blocks as a note.
- You can change how quickly or slowly their music is played using the slider



5. Creating digital music

- A composition includes a rhythm and a sequence of notes
- Main compositions are saved by the save button and then on 'Copy Link' on the next screen.



6. Reviewing and editing music

- When work is saved, it creates a new link rather than reusing the previous link.
