4. Layers and objects	Clones	An identical copy of something.
 Each object that is added to a drawing is placed on a new layer. Different layers of colour (dark and light) can help make vector drawings look more realistic. Layering smaller objects around your drawing can make it blend in more 	What's added first?	
 5. Manipulating objects Selecting multiple objects and copying them makes it easier to create images. You can select more than one object by dragging over them. Or you can hold the Shift key and click them. 	Which object would you need to draw first?
