<ul> <li>Poem Portraits</li> <li>Backgrounds can help extend simple drawings.</li> <li>Backgrounds choices of texture and colour can also effect how the viewer will feel and represent what the artist was feeling.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Developing Drawings</li> <li>Angles can help change the effect of a portrait.</li> <li>A portrait is traditionally of someone's head and shoulders.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Self-portraits</li> <li>Self-portraits are portraits of the artist they are by.</li> <li>Self-portraits are great for showcasing mixed media talents like Chila Kumari Singh Burman uses.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Changing Faces</li> <li>Self-portraits can represent something important or the feelings of an artist.</li> <li>Ways to change a portrait include: Cut the photo and rearrange it; use just a piece/pieces of the photo and draw the rest of their self-portrait; draw/paint/stick on top of or around the photo.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Mixed-media Portraits</li> <li>Feedback to other artists is usually constructive, stating how it made the viewer feel, what they liked, and how they could improve it.</li> <li>Feedback can be used to inform a final piece.</li> </ul>
