



1. What is the importance of the value of love? How did Jesus teach his followers to love?

- Christians believe that the love of God is the greatest treasure; that giving your life for others is the greatest love, and that in the end, love wins and even death will be destroyed.



2. What do Jesus' parables about forgiveness teach to Christians today?

- In the Parable of the Two Debtors, Luke 7:36–50, Jesus teaches that we all need forgiveness, but those of us who need it most may be the most grateful!
- In the Parable of the Unforgiving Servant, Matthew 18:21–35, Jesus teaches that a thankful response to God's generous forgiveness is to forgive others who do wrong to us



3. How do Christians today try to follow Jesus' teaching about justice and fairness?

- Jesus' teaching: 'Whoever wants to be the first must be the last of all, must be the servant of all.' Mark 9:35–37; not just speaking about justice but practising it, Luke 11:39–42.
- Mother Theresa is someone who has lived through Jesus' words.



4. What did Jesus teach about being generous and being greedy?

- "Hurry down, Zacchaeus, because I must stay in your house today." The people started grumbling because Jesus was going to the home of a sinner. However, Zacchaeus promised to give half his belongings to the poor and pay back four times as much to anyone he had cheated.
