#### Christians and how to live: 'What would Jesus do'?





# 1. What is the importance of the value of love? How did Jesus teach his followers to love?

• Christians believe that the love of God is the greatest treasure; that giving your life for others is the greatest love, and that in the end, love wins and even death will be destroyed.



# 2. What do Jesus' parables about forgiveness teach to Christians today?

- In the Parable of the Two Debtors, Luke 7:36–50, Jesus teaches that we all need forgiveness, but those of us who need it most may be the most grateful!
- In the Parable of the Unforgiving Servant, Matthew 18:21–35, Jesus teaches that a thankful response to God's generous forgiveness is to forgive others who do wrong to us



### 3. How do Christians today try to follow Jesus' teaching about justice and fairness?

- Jesus' teaching: 'Whoever wants to be the first must be the last of all, must be the servant of all.' Mark 9:35–37; not just speaking about justice but practising it, Luke 11:39–42.
- Mother Theresa is someone who has lived through Jesus' words.



#### 4. What did Jesus teach about being generous and being greedy?

 "Hurry down, Zacchaeus, because I must stay in your house today." The people started grumbling because Jesus was going to the home of a sinner. However, Zacchaeus promised to give half his belongings to the poor and pay back four times as much to anyone he had cheated.
