







Music Knowledge Organiser Year 1 - Hey You

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Song for the lesson;</u> It's Like That by RUN-DMC</p> <p><u>Key learning:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • RUN-DMC are one of the most influential acts in the history of hip hop culture • They pushed hip hop music into mainstream pop music and made it popular. 	

Key Words

Imagination	Ideas of your own about the music.

Appraise	Listening carefully and think about key points of the music.
