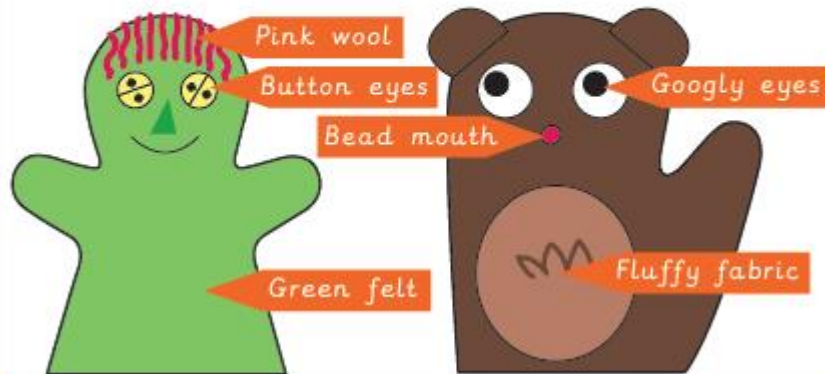


You will use a variety of techniques to create your puppet including cutting, gluing, stapling and pinning.

**Key Vocabulary**

Template	A template is a form, mold or pattern used as a guide to make something.
Model	An example of the product made.
Staple	A small metal pin that joins things together from a stapler.
Safety pin	A small metal fastener to join fabric or pin something to another object.
Fabric	A type of cloth.
