## Why do Christians call the day Jesus died 'Good Friday'?



### 1. What do some Christians think is Salvation?

- Holy Week is the last week before Jesus is resurrected,
- The events of Holy Week: Palm Sunday, The Last Supper (Maundy Thursday), Good Friday, Easter Sunday.
- Christians believe that Jesus came to Earth to be our saviour.



### 2. How do you think Mary might have been feeling during Holy Week?

- Mary was the mother of Jesus.
- There is evidence in the Bible that Mary was there when Jesus was put on the cross, died and rose again.
- Christians believe that Jesus died to save us from our sins.



### 3. How do you think Christians feel about Holy week?

- By Jesus dying and being resurrected, restored the relationship between God and humanity.
- Christians believe anyone can be saved and go back to God.



### 4. Why is the Easter story important to Christians today?

- Easter is the most important festival for Christians and it is a time when they remember the crucifixion of Jesus on Good Friday and his resurrection on Easter Sunday.
- In the big story of the Bible, Christians believe that the Fall led to a split between humans and God.



### 5. Why does this story provoke hope, sadness and joy?

- Christians today might feel differently to how some of his followers might have felt at the time.
- Christians believe that Jesus died so that people would receive forgiveness for the sins they have committed.
- Jesus' death led to the salvation of humanity and restored the relationship with God as they were during the Creation and before the Fall.

## Key Vocabulary

<b>Salvation</b>	Being saved or rescued so that Christians are no longer away from God.
<b>Save</b>	Being saved from sin.
<b>Rescue</b>	To be free from danger or evil.
<b>Holy Week</b>	The last week of Jesus' life
<b>Easter</b>	The Christian festival which remembers the resurrection of Jesus.
<b>Communities</b>	A group of people who have things in common.
