Aerial View	A picture taken from the air.
Distance	The measure of space between things, place or points in time.
Settlements	A place where people have recently settled to live

Human features	Show how humans have altered the environment e.g. buildings, houses, shops.
Physical features	Natural features e.g. beaches, cliffs, forest.
OS map	A detailed map of the UK that uses scales, keys and grid references.
