



Year 3 CLASS NEWSLETTER

We would like to share with you about some of the amazing things we have been doing in the autumn term.



In **Science**, we have looked at a variety of different rock and soils. We did a lot of group work to plan and conduct investigations which got us thinking scientifically. We then looked at Animals including Humans where we identified some of our most important bones and muscles in the body. We categorised different types of skeletons for animals and even got a chance to look at real animal skulls to determine their characteristics.

In **English**, we have read lots of different types of texts and even had a go at acting these out with a story map in our Talk for Writing sessions. We learnt how to write instructions for a purpose, limerick poems, fable story, recount and a play script. We had a lot of fun using drama to understand the key features of the text. Handwriting and presentation have been a big focus in our English lessons.



In **Maths**, we have been using a variety of representations such as the bar model, part-whole model, and place value chart to understand the place value of 3-digit numbers. We have learnt how to use the column method for addition and subtraction. We have also been learning multiplication and division and understanding what the symbols represent. We have been trying really hard to deepen our understanding working on our reasoning skills.




Richard the Third and Snowdome
