











Music Knowledge Organiser Year 3 – Glockenspiel Stage 1

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Song for the lesson:</u> Easy E</p> <p><u>Key learning:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> You can feel the pulse by nodding your head or tapping your feet to the music. A pulse can have a number of counts. Easy E has a pulse of groups of 4. Numbers at the start of the piece are called 'time signatures'. Each bar is separated by 'bar lines'. 	
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Song for the lesson:</u> Drive</p> <p><u>Key learning:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Minims are each worth 2 counts. A crotchet rest is worth 1 count. Crotchets are used to let us know which note to play. 	
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Song for the lesson:</u> DeeCee's Blues</p> <p><u>Key learning:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rhythm is made of long and short sounds. All songs have a rhythm. The five lines are called a 'stave'. 	
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Song for the lesson:</u> D-E-F-inately</p> <p><u>Key learning:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Each note has a different sound. The word pitch describes how high or low a sound is. 	
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Song for the lesson:</u> March of the Golden Guards</p> <p><u>Key learning:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A semibreve is worth 4 counts. A semibreve rest is worth 4 counts. 	
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Song for the lesson:</u> Bongo Beach</p> <p><u>Key learning:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> We can improve a piece of music by using a digital device. We can improve by changing the notes in a bar or changing the rhythm. 	

Key Words

Rhythm	Long and short sounds or patterns that happen over the pulse.
Pulse	The regular heartbeat of the music; the steady beat.
Pitch	High and low sounds.
Improvise	To make up a tune and play it on the spot.
Tempo	The speed of the music – fast, slow or in-between.
