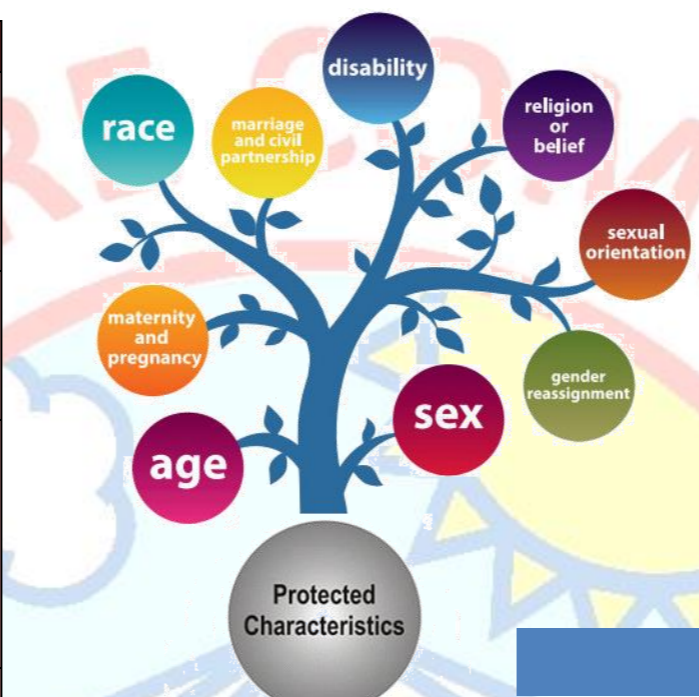


| British Values Key Vocabulary                               |   |

| British value of democracy                                  | democracy, vote, voting, secret ballot, government, one person one vote, laws, rules, parliament, council, representative, campaign, democratic change, society     |
| British Value of rule of law                                | law, rules, everyone, rights and responsibilities, police, courts, proper order, safety, wellbeing.   |
| British value of mutual respect and tolerance for diversity | respect, mutual (two way), diversity (gender, disability, faith, belief, ethnicity), care, friendship, everyone has beliefs and some people have religious beliefs. |
| British Value of individual liberty                         | choice, own beliefs, freedoms, liberty, individual, each person, protect.   |

**Fundraising:** Children in Need, Red nose Day, Jeans for Genes, Christmas Jumper Day (save the children), Harvest Festival.

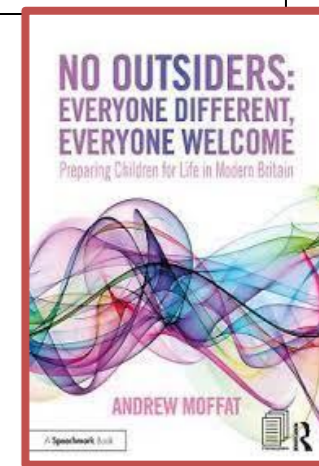

**Assemblies:** Everyone Welcome, Picture News, Protected characteristics, Values, Awareness Days. Visitors assemblies

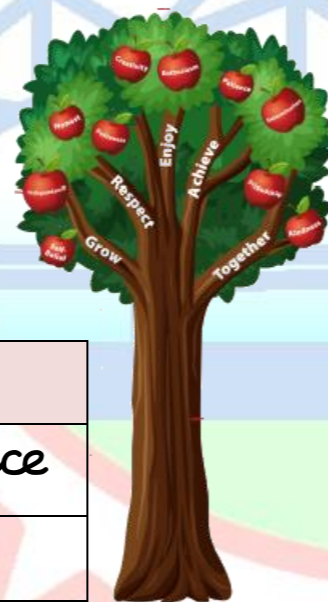
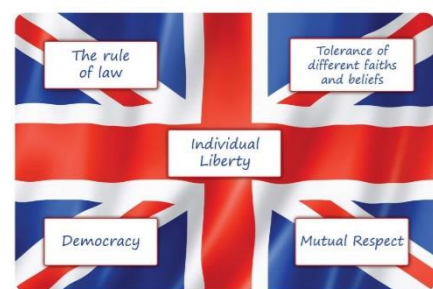
