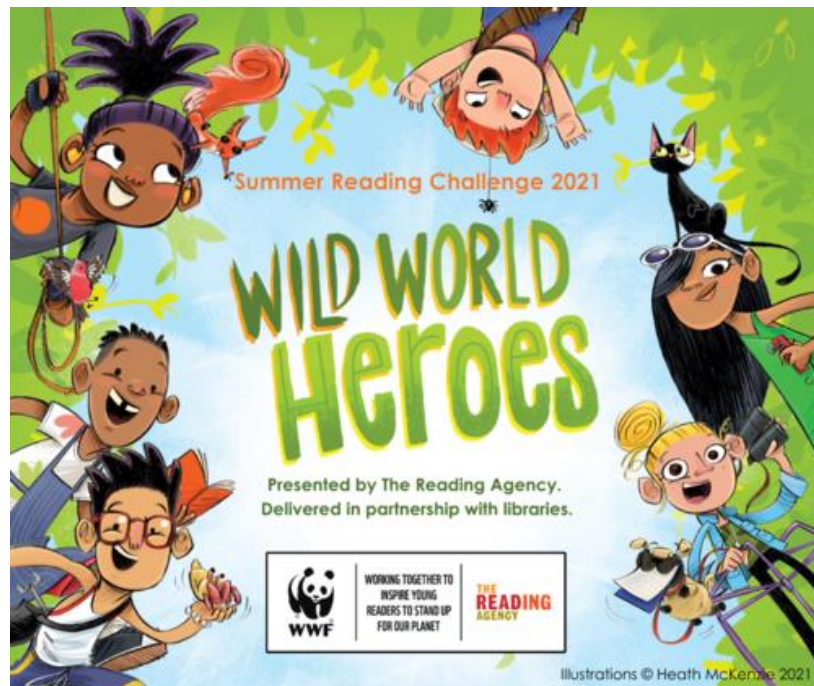


**We're excited to reveal the theme for the Summer Reading Challenge 2021!

Who is it for?

For children aged 4-12 years.

When does it start?

It starts on Saturday 3rd July – Saturday 4th September

How do children get involved?

Children will need to have their own library card to take part in the Summer Reading Challenge. If your children are not members of a library, you can either apply for a card here:

or they can visit their local library and sign up for a library card.

What happens next?

The children will visit the library and collect their first incentives from Saturday 3rd July. Over the summer help them to complete the challenge by reading, listening to or sharing 6 library books or eBooks over the summer.

If you make 2 visits to the library over the summer children can collect incentives and a medal along the way.

At Glenmere, we hope as many children will take part as possible.

If you are taking part online, all you need to do is follow the four simple steps:

1. Create a profile and choose your avatar.
2. Start reading and add books that you have read to your profile.
3. Review books to unlock badges.
4. Play games and enter competitions.
