
We would like to share with you about some of the things we have been doing in the spring term.





In **Science**, we have looked at and discussed different materials. We went on a material walk and found lots of things that were made using different materials. We learnt about where the materials come from, whether they are natural or manmade and we also took part with investigations to see which materials float or sink and which materials are waterproof or not. It was great fun!



In **English**, we have been learning how to write sentences using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. We have read lots of stories and even had a go at acting some of these out in our Talk for Writing sessions. We learnt The Three Little Pigs off by heart and had a go at changing the animals in the story and writing it all on our own. We found out what conjunctions are and are still trying to include adjectives in our writing.





In **Maths**, we have been exploring numbers to 50, counting in 2s and 5s and investigating length and height. We have learnt how to measure using a ruler and know that cm stands for centimetres. We also continued to enjoy finding out about number bonds to 10 and 20! We have used the part, part whole model and used dienes to understand tens ones. We have been trying really hard to deepen our understanding working on our reasoning skills completing a question everyday together.
