Children will focus today on identifying where Kampong Ayer is in relation to the equator. This will be compared with the UK. What does this mean for differences in time and climate? What is their population like compared to ours? 2. Today we will focus on the homes in Kampong Ayer. How do the houses there compare to those that we live in? What do you notice about the levels of the houses? How are they laid out? Etc. 3. Today we will focus closely on how the weather in Kampong Ayer compares to our weather in the United Kingdom. What do we know about its position on the globe? What do we know about the southern hemisphere compared to the northern hemisphere? Why do the people of Kampong Ayer use umbrellas? Is it just to stay dry from rain? 4. Today's focus is on means of travel. What do you notice about where Kampong Ayer is situated? If it is on water, what are the main ways that people travel from one place to another? How does this differ to where we live? How is it similar to our needs for transport? 5. Today's focus is on schooling in Kampong Ayer compared to our school. What do children wear at school? What facilities do they have that are the same as ours? How do children travel to and from school? What foods do they eat throughout the day? 6. Today we will look at the natural environment around Kampong Ayer and how it differs to ours. What is the climate like? What types of plants and animals live and grow there? What do we know about rainforests? 7. Today we will be using Geographic Information System (GIS) imagery to look at and compare Kampong Ayer with Leicester.
